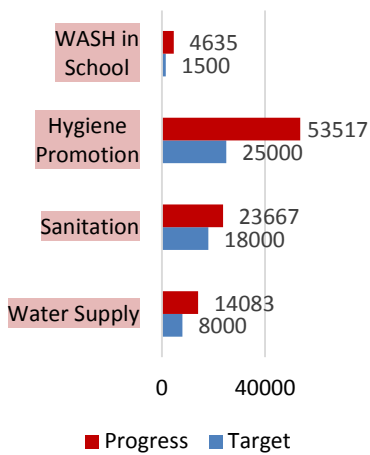

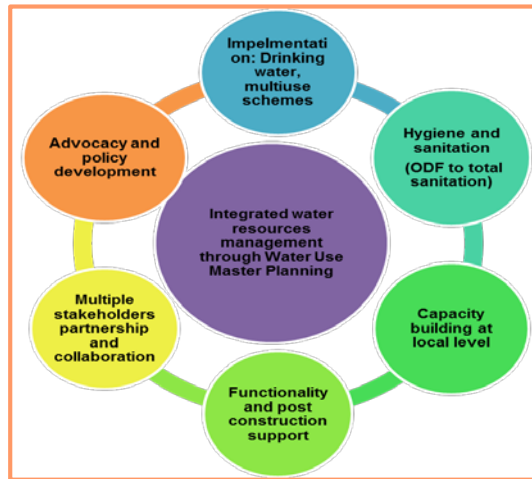

Approach, methods and strategy



Learning

- A survey on quality of water revealed that quality deteriorates significantly from point of collection to point of use due to poor hygiene/ handling practices
- Research on local situation and effective awareness campaigns are instrumental to make people adopt new technology / device
- People are overwhelmingly satisfied with Rainwater Harvesting schemes
- Activation of Water User and Sanitation Committees (WUSCs) and private connection have positive impacts on functional status of drinking water schemes



Advocacy & policy

- Evidence based advocacy & policy interventions
- Provided input on wash sector development plan (WASH SDP)
- As a part of WASH SDP, National Guideline on WUMP approach under preparation in coordination with Sector Efficiency Improvement Unit/Ministry of Urban Development and Rural Village Water Resources management Project
- Participating WASH platform meeting at regional and national level, actively participated WASH cluster meeting during earthquake disaster
- Provided inputs on rain water harvesting guideline, total sanitation guideline which are under preparation by Department Water Supply & Sewerage
- Consortium projects supported Federation of Water and Sanitation Users in Nepal to organize WASH summit II, with theme on gender equality and social inclusion and governance.
